

Young people on campus 2023

Maximum number of young people (total)

- Oberstown is certified to accommodate a total of 46 young people between the ages of 10 and 18 years.
- The maximum number of male occupants is 40.
- The maximum number of female occupants is 6.
- Young people live in residential units housing a maximum of 8 young people.
 Male and female occupants live in separate units.
- Each young person has their own room. Oberstown is never overcrowded.

Number of young people detained on remand or detention orders

- There were 129 young people resident on campus during 2023
 - 127 male
 - 2 female
 - 34 young people were already in Oberstown on 31/12/22
 - 95 new admissions in 2023
 - 59 on detention orders
 - 70 on remand orders only
- Average length of detention order 138 days
- Average length of remand order 44 days
- Number of court escorts 573

Average daily population 2023

- The average daily number of young people on campus was 35
 - 13 on remand
 - 22 on detention orders

Demographic information 2023

- Average age 16 years
- 53 (41%) from Dublin
- 12 (9%) of non-Irish origin
- 27 (21%) from the Irish Traveller Community



Onward placements 2023

A total of **116** young people left Oberstown in 2023

- **74 (64%)** Home
- 16 (14%) Residential care
- 14 (12%) Other
- 12 (10%) Irish Prison Service

Oberstown Campus School is run by the Dublin and Dun Laoghaire Education and Training Board.

Afterschool activities classes

Young people attend afterschool activities each weekday evening.

60-70 afterschool sessions every weekday, held over a four-hour period.

- 24.5 Hectare site (60 acres)

Service and staff

- Oberstown is a 24/7:365 round the clock, every day of the year service
- There is a full time equivalent complement of 248 staff
 - 51% Female
 - 49% Male
- 177 staff are directly involved in front-line care of young people

Financial allocation 2023

Oberstown's budget is allocated by the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth (DCEDIY)

- €28.544m financial allocation

 - €2.220 Pensions
 - €5.713 Non-pay
