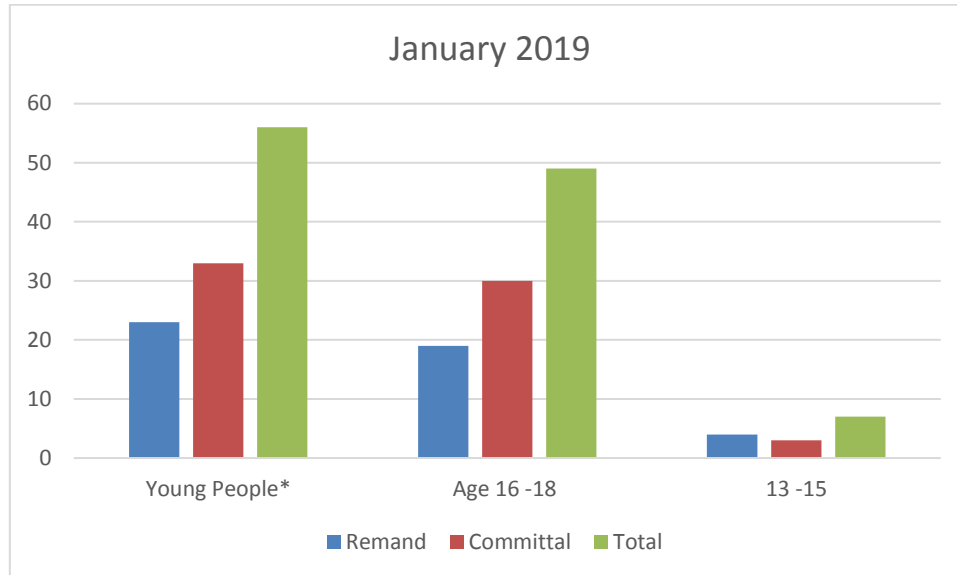


## Statistical breakdown of young people on campus, January 2019

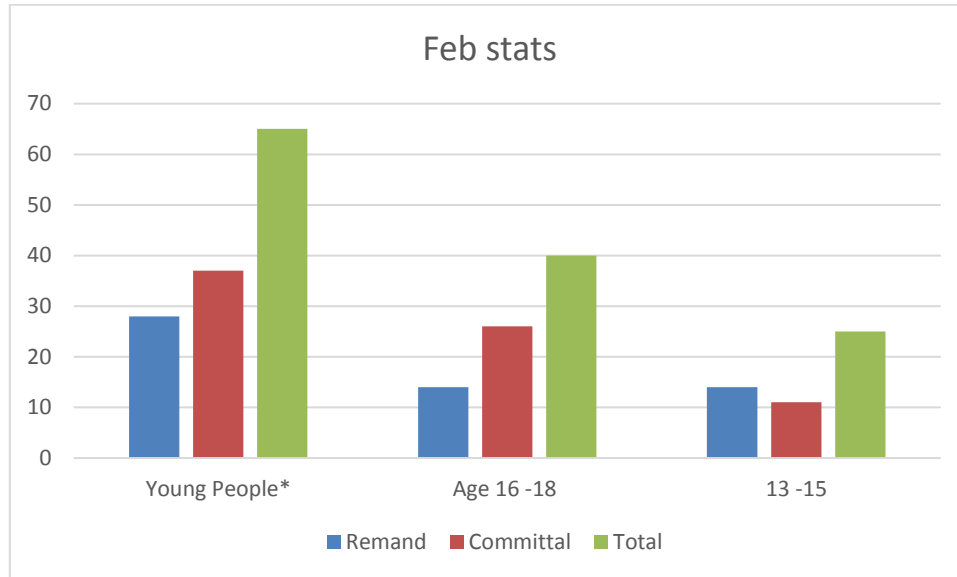


	<b>Young People*</b>	<b>Age 16 -18</b>	<b>13 -15</b>

## Statistical breakdown of young people on campus, February 2019

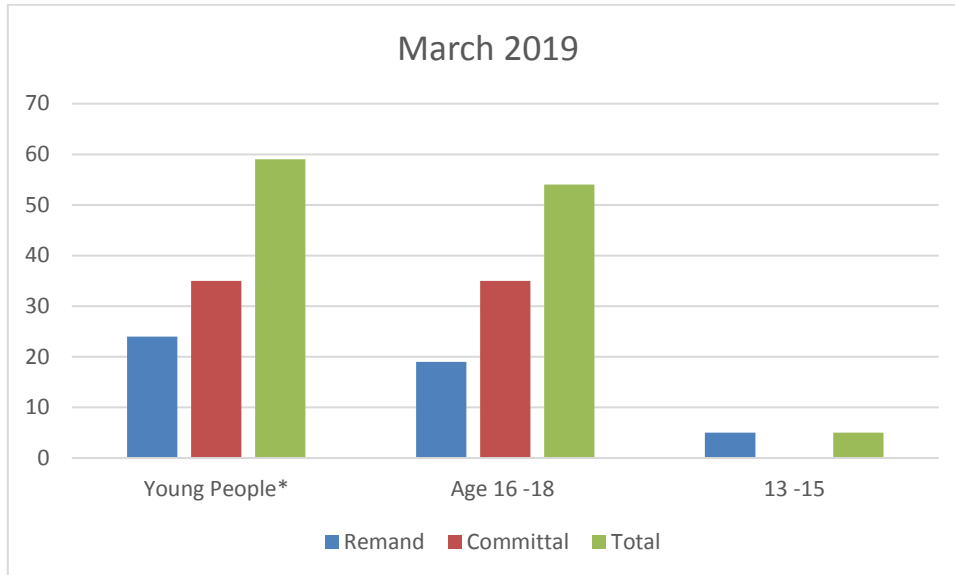

## Statistical breakdown of young people on campus, March 2019

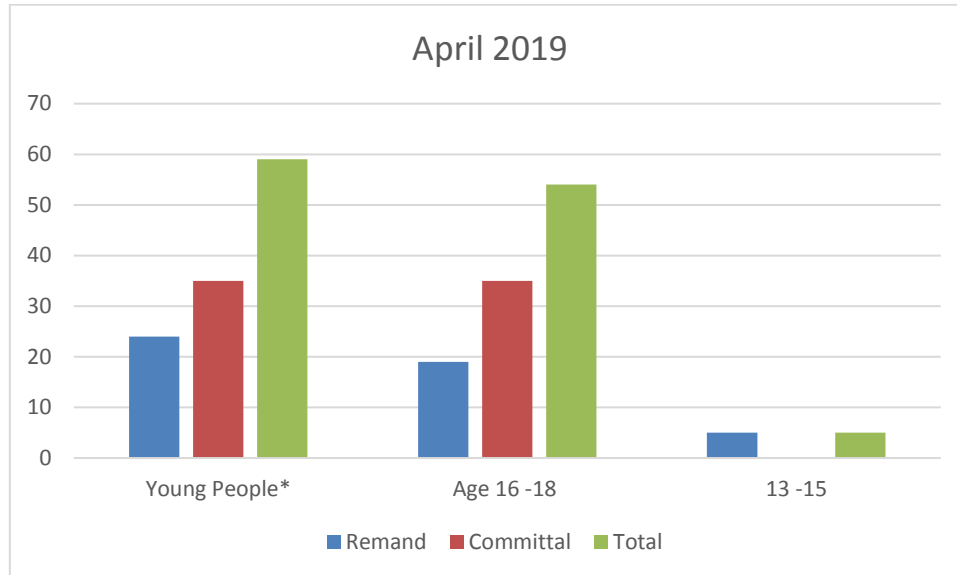

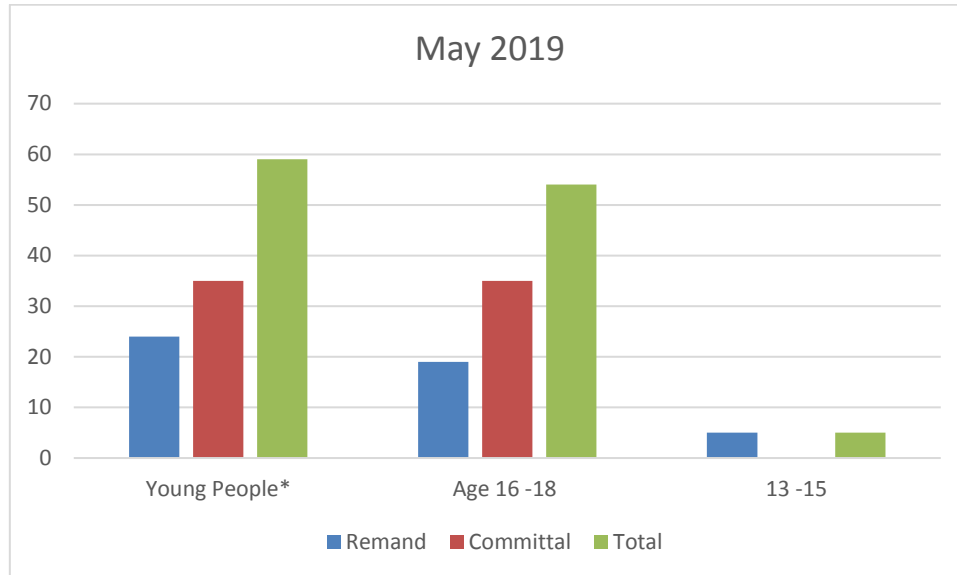

## Statistical breakdown of young people on campus, May 2019

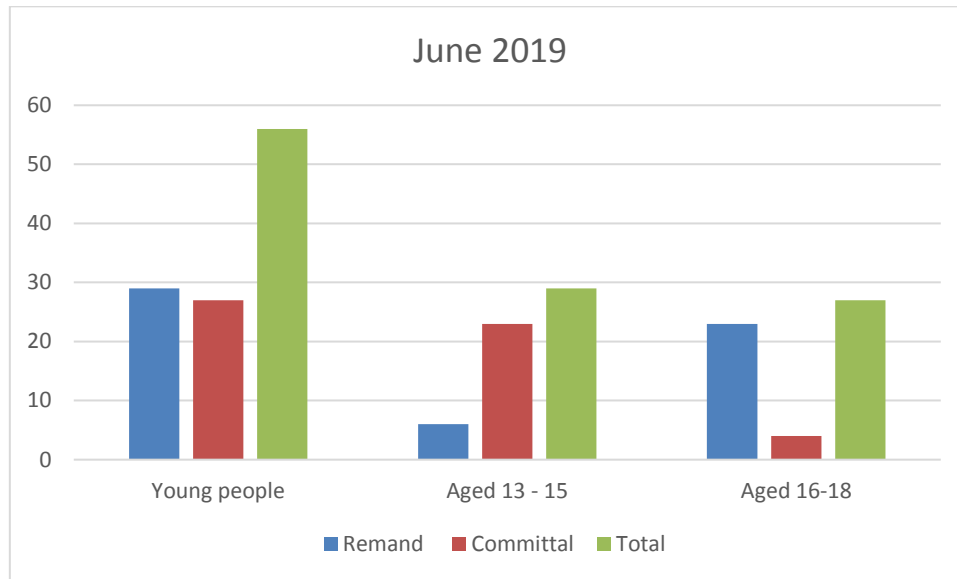

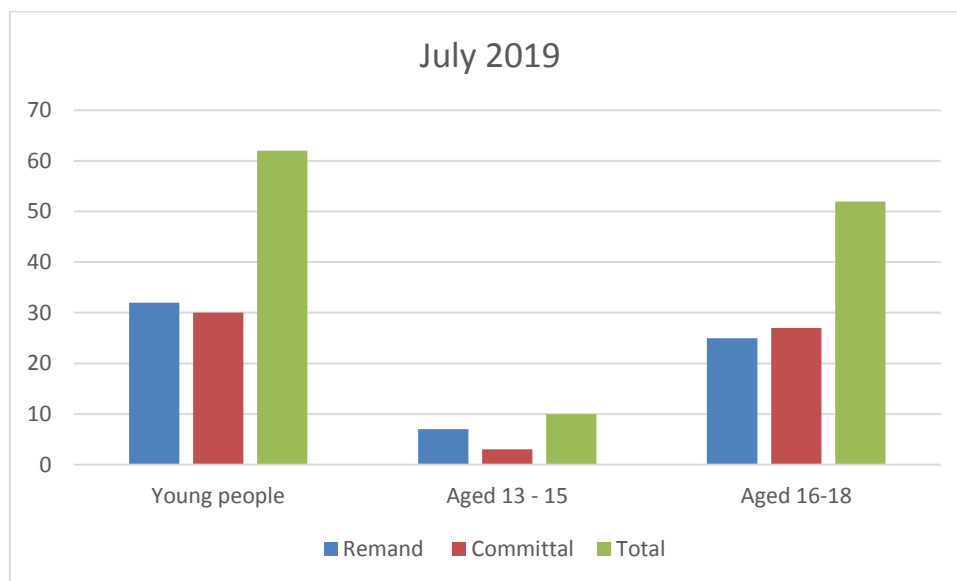

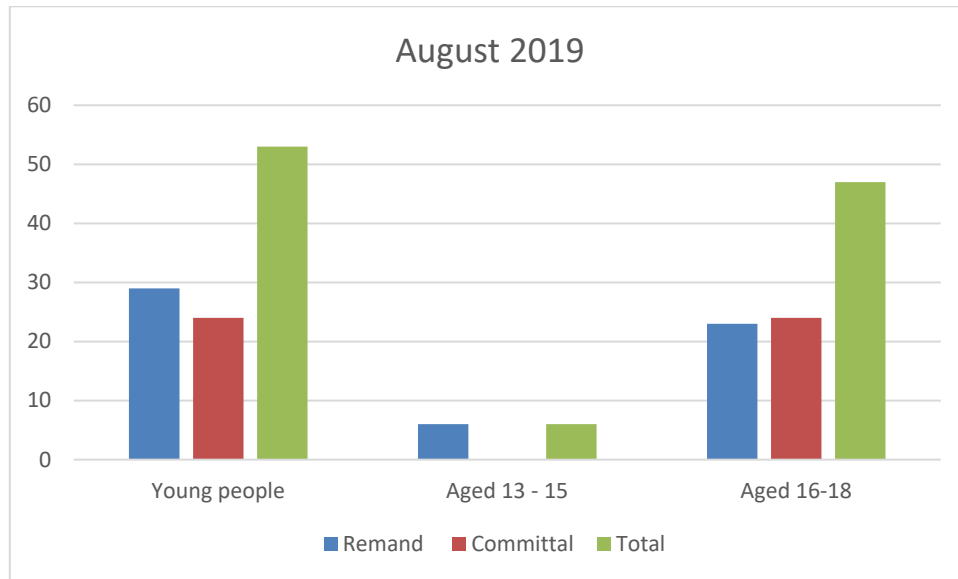

### Statistical Breakdown of Young People on Campus August 2019



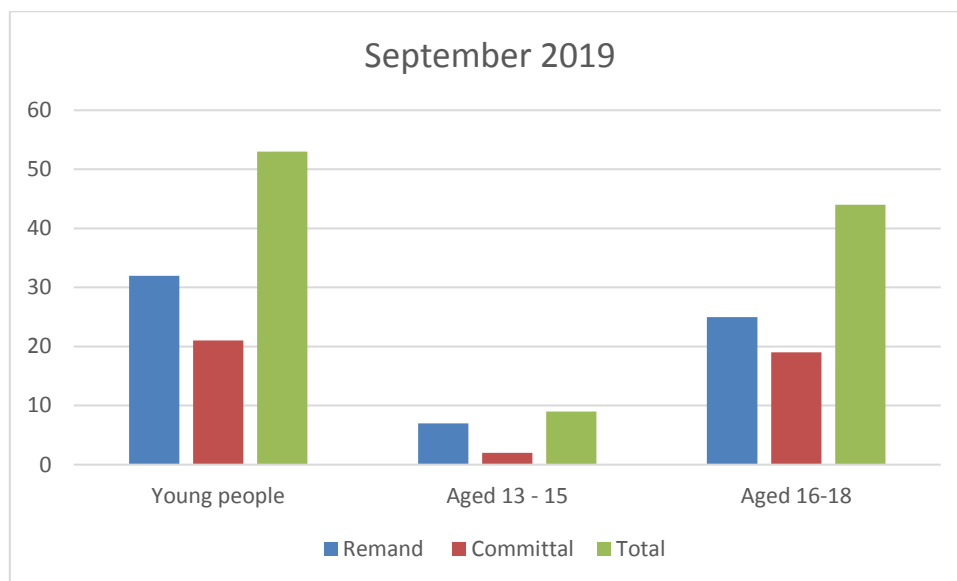

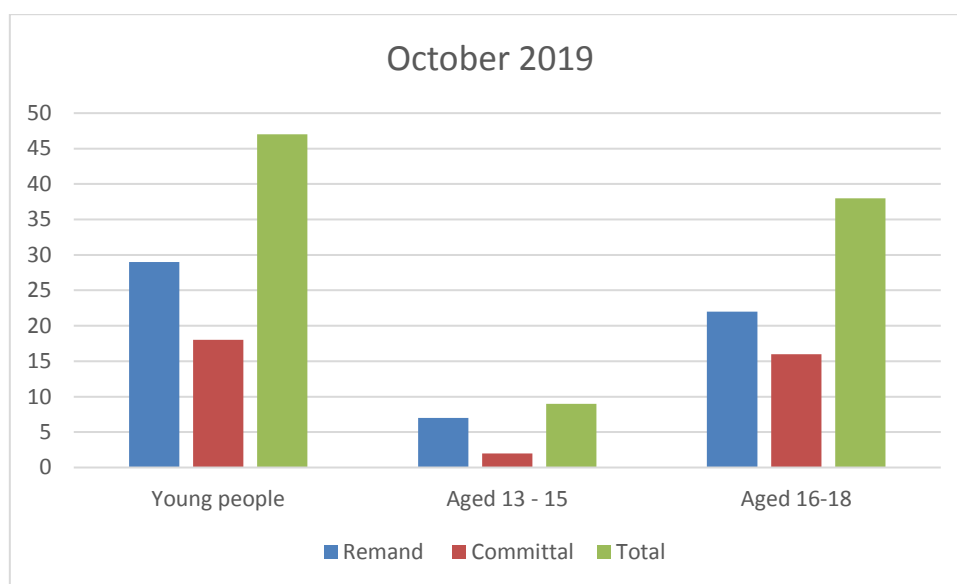

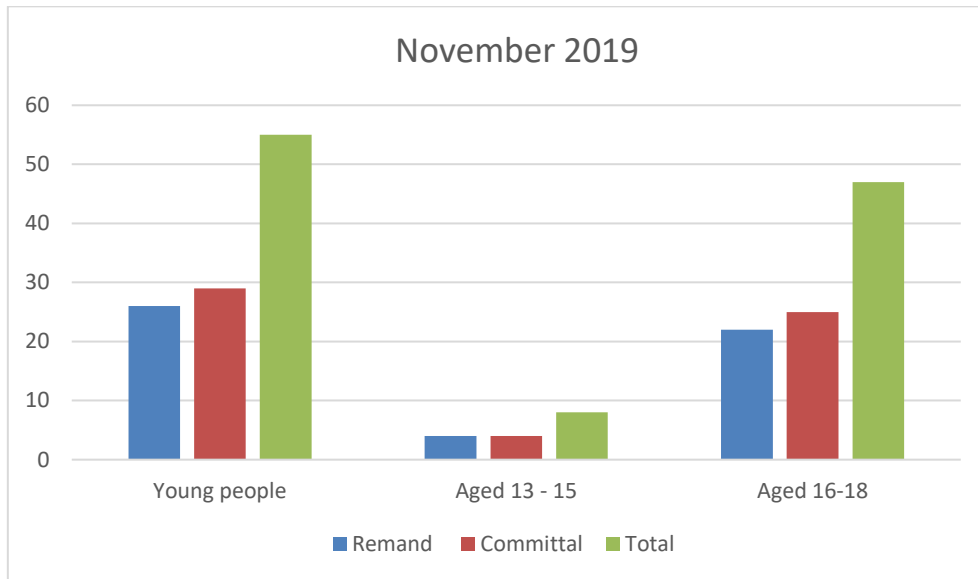

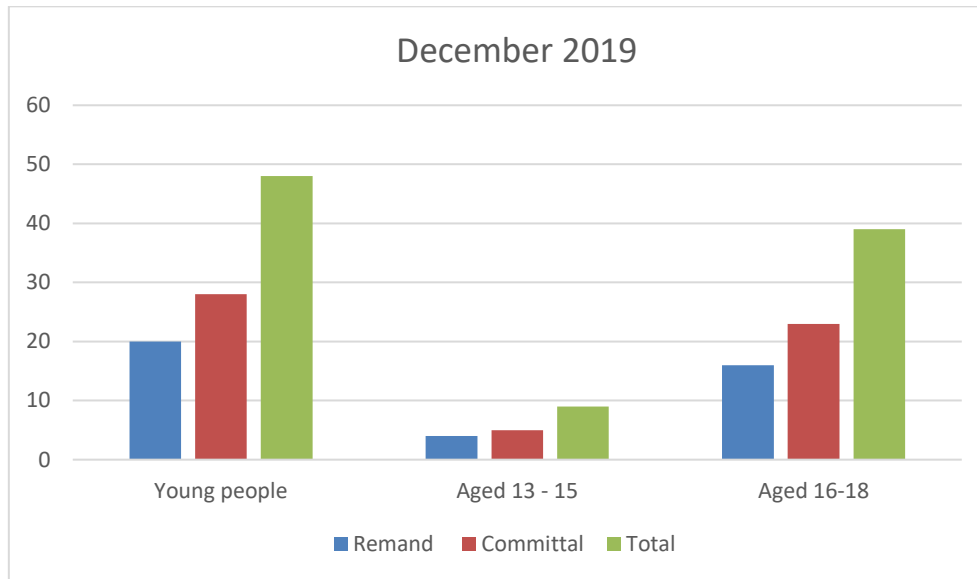
